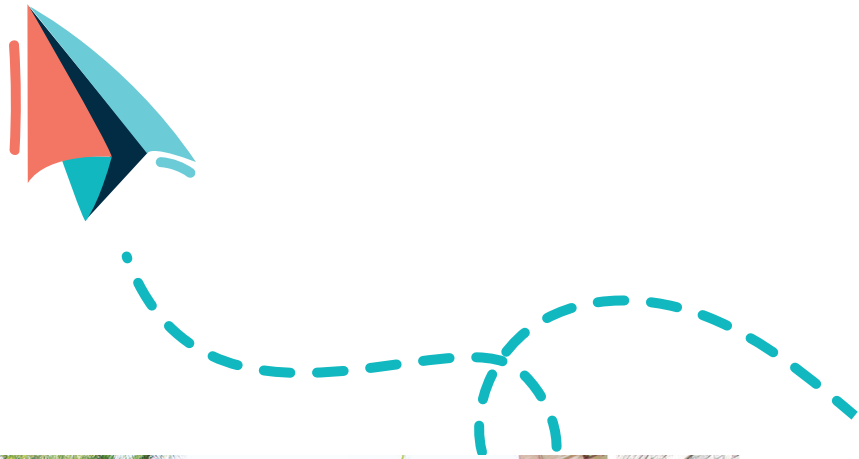
We Believe

Nurturing Holistic Education

KiiT International School, Bhubaneswar offers International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGSCE) and International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) as the international curricula and CBSE as the National curriculum.

We sincerely believe education is the doorway towards excellence. Our committed faculty, world class infrastructure and facility makes sure that each child is nurtured with love, empathy and care.

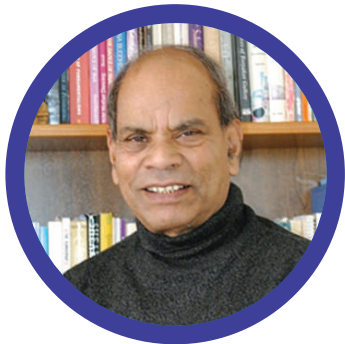

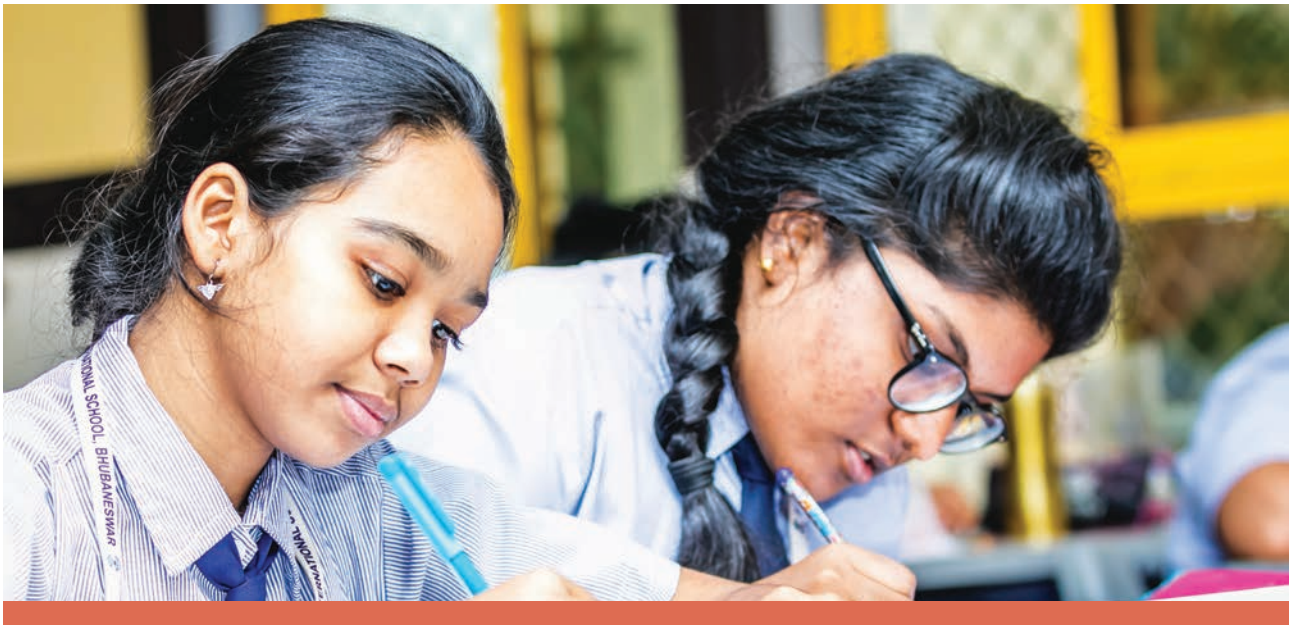

International Primary Years Programme at Kiit International School is a Transdisciplinary Framework for students during the formative years from Grade 1 till Grade 5.

The IPYP is a voyage of learning through inquiry-based and student-centered education through exploration, discovery and reflection enabling students to learn between, across and beyond traditional subject boundaries. The foundations of literacy, numeric reflection and thinking skills are laid down for the future here.

The IPYP curriculum prepares students for Secondary Education Cambridge Lower secondary programme and IB Middle Year Programme.

Curriculum

The curriculum framework strives to maintain a balance between search for knowledge and concepts, acquisition of skills, developing a positive attitude and create opportunities to take the learning outside the classroom for positive action and reflection.

The subject areas taught are

- » Language (English and Second Language).
- » The Second Language options are Hindi, French or Spanish
- » Literacy (Information and Digital), Numeracy, Science and Social studies.
- » The students are also taught skills in Arts (Visual and Performing), Global perspectives and Personal, Social and Physical education.
- » Through PSPE lessons and assemblies we emphasise the importance of life skills such as: respect, honesty, kindness and independence.



Other Activities

Students learn Creya, Coding, Dance, Instrumental and Swimming, Students also celebrate and jointly plan and organise international and national days with their teachers. After school activities are also offered for students wishing to be trained in specific sports activities.

At KiiTIS some activities or celebrations are naturally integrated in the unit of inquiry.

While we highlight foundational skills in Numeracy and Language and teach it as standalones the rest of the subjects especially Science and social studies are taught through transdisciplinary themes.



International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP)



IBDP is a two-year programme designed for the students aged 16-19. It is a pre-university course which was developed in 1960s in Geneva by a Group of international educators. Its main aim is to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) is a rigorous two-year course of study in Grade XI and XII, designed to prepare students for the challenges of university studies and life beyond. The balance of a demanding academic programme and the all round development of personality is the hallmark of the IBDP.

How Does the IB Achieve its Aim?

The IB works with universities in nearly 140 countries. Since 1983, the IB has been recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as an entry qualification (equivalent to +2 qualification of an Indian Board) to all universities in India. IB Students learn more than a body

of Knowledge. The Diploma Programme prepares students for university and encourages them to:

- Ask challenging questions
- Learn how to learn
- Develop a strong sense of their own identity and culture
- Develop the ability to communicate with and understand people from other countries and cultures.



How is the Curriculum Designed?

The curriculum contains six subject groups together with the DP core: creativity, action, service (CAS); the extended essay (EE); and theory of Knowledge (TOK).

Boarding Facilities

The boarding facilities at KiiT International School for students across India and around the world are like a home away from home. Rooms are spacious and well-furnished. The boarding facility is air-conditioned and Wi-Fi enabled. Girls and boys facilities are administered by their respective House Parents and overseen by the Boarding Superintendent respectively. Our dedicated House Parents stay on campus with the students to look after every need of the boarders, be it academics or personal.

The school ensures safety and security for all its students. There is a 24-hour vigil around the entire campus. Only parents and authorized guardians are allowed to meet their children during visiting hours. Regular visits, excursions, outings and shopping tours are organized for boarders on weekends under supervision.

Counselling

Career guidance counselling is an integral part of our education programme, facilitating the transition into KIIT University, other institutions within India, or universities and colleges in other countries. KiiT International School emphasizes the development of life and study skills from the early years until graduation. On-campus professional and personal counsellors are available for students to ensure that all emotional needs are addressed.

Infrastructure and Facilities

Our purpose-built green campus, located in a clean and unpolluted environment, helps provide a world-class education facility for all students. Residences, multi-purpose halls, libraries, state-of-the-art science labs, 3D movie hall, an on-campus medical centre, and the multi-cuisine cafeteria are all air-conditioned along with a fully Wi-fi enabled campus.

Sports, Recreation & Art Activities

Activities are an integral part of a student's life which help develop interests and abilities beyond the regular curriculum. All students participate in activities, which are conducted under the supervision of a qualified instructor. Sports facilities include badminton, tennis, volleyball and basketball courts, an indoor swimming pool, large and small grass playing-fields for Soccer, Rugby, Cricket, Hockey, and access to the KiiT indoor and outdoor stadiums which house many facilities including Archery and Judo. Special support is provided for sports achievers in academics. The scientifically designed, structured Edu-Sports programmes help physical education and sports acquire the same level of rigor and focus that exists in academic subjects in schools.
